Roma Nascosta - Hidden places of the eternal city

Duration: 2,5-3 hours

Price of this tour is 40 euros with a maximum 15 participants per guide.

This walking tour runs deliberately off the beaten tracks. Discovering Rome's hidden secrets, forgotten ancient Ruins in the urban area, narrow medieval alleys deep near the Capitol Hill, hidden Renaissance-courtyards and magnificent Baroque squares.

Transport and directions

Getting there

Rome has two airports – the main airport Fiumicino Leonardo Da Vinci and the other one is Ciampino Airport.

Public Transport

Fiumicino Airport is well connected to Rome city centre by train, with regular departures from the train station located in Terminal 3. The express train goes from Fiumicino Airport to Rome Termini Railway-station (arriving in platform 23 or 24), where you will find the Metro lines A and B. The train runs every 15 minutes, with the first one departing at 6:23 am and the last one at 11:23 pm. It costs €16 one way for adults, free for children under the age of 4, and children aged 4 to 12 can run for free with a paying adult. You can buy tickets online (www.trenitalia.com) or directly at the train station, either from the vending machine or from the kiosk.

Taxis

Taxis from Fiumicino Airport to Rome: A taxi can be a convenient and fast way to get from Fiumicino to Rome. If your accommodation is inside the ancient Aurelian walls, there is a flat fee of fixed 50€ for a maximum of 3 costumers including 3 suitcases. If the Hotel is outside the walls, the taxi runs on taximeter. Depending on traffic, the cost will be about 60-70€.

Private transfers from Fiumicino Airport to Rome

RomaCulta (organiser of the tourist tour) can also organize private transfers, in both directions. Please use this mail address to book: ECBA.transfers@gmail.com

For the reservation you will need to mail:

- 1) Name/surname of the costumers; 2) Arrival date, airline, Arrival time;
- 4) An active cell-phone number; 5) Name of the Accommodation; 6) A Billing Address

The day before the transfer you will receive a SMS (4) with the name of the driver.

The driver will wait directly at the Gate holding a nameplate (1).

The service can be cancelled free of charge until 24h before the arrival date.

The prices are for a one-way-transfer:

- max. 3 persons with suitcases: Mercedes E-Class & Driver costs 75€ (+20% between 10PM and 6AM)

- from 4 up to max. 7 persons with suitcases: Mercedes Mini-Van & Driver costs 150€ (+20% between 10PM and 6AM)

Transfer organised by your hotel

You can ask also your hotel if they do private transfers as they are usually about the same price.
