

JUDICIAL ADMINISTRATION SINCE 2012



President

Council (NJC)

14+1 members

President of the Kúria

(Supreme Court)

NATIONAL JUDICIAL COUNCIL

- 14 Members elected by judges
- Ex-officio Member: President of the Kúria
- No legal entity
- No staff (only one secretary, employed by NJO)
- No independent budget
- Advisory competences, very rare veto powers
- EU RoL Reports, GRECO, Venice Commission:
 NJC's position should be strengthened

THE EXPERIENCE IN A NUTSHELL

- 2018-19: Serious conflicts between NJC and former NJO President (constitutional crisis)
- 2020: New Kúria President's candidation not supported by NJC (opinion disregarded)
- 2020-21: Kúria strengthened (limited case law)
- 2022: NJC's criticism on judicial appointments
- Smear campaigns against NJC Members

THE 2022 MASSIVE SMEAR CAMPAIGN

CHILLING

EFFECT

ALERT



After a formal and official meeting with the US Ambassador (David Pressman),
Judges Vasvári and Matusik (Members of NJC) were being heavily attacked,
discredited and called upon to resign by the government controlled media, think
tanks and politicians, claiming that they are not independent in their judicial capacity.
More than 450 online articles and state media broadcasts for over 1 month!

NJC, MABIE (Hungarian Association of Judges), EAJ, ENCJ, US Embassy
statements expressed solidarity and condemned the full-scale smear campaign.

2023 Judicial Reform

- Requested by the European Union
- NJC and NGOs commented on the draft
- Draft proposal submitted to Parliament
- NJC's status would be strengthened (legal entity, independent budget, staff, binding opinions)
- From June 2023
- New NJC elections in Q4 2023: we will see...

C-564/2019 (Pest Central District Court)

Preliminary request on 3 questions (judiciary)

Kúria: Determination of illegality

CHILLING EFFECT ALERT

- Disciplinary against the judge (withdrawn)
- 2 additional questions by the judge

CJEU: Remedy & disciplinary breaches EU law

LEGAL REMEDY SUBMITTED ON THE GROUND OF LEGALITY

- Sections 666-669 of Criminal Procedure Code
- Only Prosecutor General may submit the motion to the Kúria
- Legislative proposal on EU request: excluded in the case of preliminary requests (from June 2023)
- NJC and NGOs proposed the exclusion of the precedent decision of the Kúria

JUDICIAL OFFICERS' SCANDAL 2022

- Criminal investigation in a high profile bribery case
- Two main suspects: Judicial Officers' President and Deputy Minister of Justice
- Media leaked a tapped telephone call between Metropolitan Court President and Judicial Officers' President about a judge
- Inquiry urged by NJC
- Inquiry report classified by NJO President, still not known
- NJC indicated unlawfulness
