- **Council of Europe** *Group of States against Corruption* (GRECO), since 1999
- OECD Convention on Combating Bribery of Foreign Public Officials in International Business Transactions, since 2000
- **Council of Europe** *Criminal Law Convention on Corruption,* since 2002
- **UN** Convention against Corruption, since 2005
- EU Convention on the Fight against Corruption involving Officials of the European Communities or Officials of Member States of the EU, since 2005
